


Instructions


The coil clamps can be used for managing fabric on the ends of a hoop frame or while off-frame quilting. **Note:** The example images show the end of a frame, but the process is the same while off-frame quilting.




Roll up the fabric you want to keep contained or out of the way.

2 Pull out the coil, and then slip the rolled fabric into the coil.





When you're ready to move the fabric, slide the rolled fabric out of the coil.



Instructions

If you are replacing a lost coil clamp, or adding coil clamps to the front rail of your Cutie Breeze frame, then the first time you use the Quilting Clips accessory, put the coil clamps on the fabric clamps. Once the coil clamps are set up, you can leave them as is. You don't need to take them apart after each use.

Do the following to assemble the coil clamps:

Slide the **coil clamps** into the groove on the side of the **fabric clamps**. Make sure the **curl** of the coil rests on top of the fabric clamp. Each fabric clamp needs one coil clamp.




Take the following steps to use the coil clamps on the rails of your frame:




Assembled Coil Clamps

Using the Coil Clamps on Frame Rails (continued)

1 Remove any clamps from the rail.




2 Put your quilt on the frame. For detailed instructions for this step, see your frame manual.




3 Press the coil clamps and the other clamps onto the rails to hold the fabric in place.

Make sure that the **end of the coil that is attached** to the clamp is on the inside of the frame. **Note:** The front clamps work best when attached from the front of the front rail, rather than from the top of the rail.




Using the Coil Clamps on Frame Rails (continued)


3 Roll up the edge of your quilt. Pull out the coil, and then slip the rolled fabric into the coil clamps.



4 When it's time to move your fabric, if some of the quilt is in your coil clamps, then slide it out of the coils before you remove the clamps.
